NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by the Sections 85 and 86, read with Sections 30, 31, 36, 37 and 37A of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 (Ben Act V of 1909), the Governor is pleased to make, with immediate effect, the following amendments in the West Bengal Excise (Selection of New Sites and Grant of License for retail sale of Liquor and certain other intoxicants) Rules, 2003, published under Notification no. 800EX dated 29.07.2003, as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the said Rules) :-

Amendments

In the said rules,-

1. Substitute Clause (XV) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 3 by “(XV) “supplementary License means a license which may be granted under rule 15 to a holder of a license mentioned in clauses (a), (c), (d) and (f) of Rule 4.”
2. Substitute category (b) of rule 4 by-
“ (b) Foreign Liquor for consumption ‘off’ the site from the opium depots/erstwhile opium depots/erstwhile ganja shop”
3. Substitute category (n) of Rule 4 by “ (n) 50⁰ UP Foreign Liquor for consumption ‘off’ and/or “On” the site”
4. Substitute category (m) of Rule 4 by “(m) foreign liquor for consumption ‘off’ and /or ‘on’ the premises of any canteen for Service Personnel or a canteen established by or for the Border Security Force or by or similar other Forces, under Central Government, engaged in protection of the border of the Country”

5. In Explanation IV of Rule 4-substitute the words and figures “(h) to (l)” by the words and figures “(i) to (l)”
6. After Explanation V to the Rule 4 add the new Explanation- “Explanation VI-For the purpose of this Rule Category (n) license shall only be granted as Supplementary Licenses as provided in Rule 15”

7. Substitute Rule 6 by the following Rule -

“6 Every License shall be granted subject to the terms and conditions as specified in the License and shall be granted in License Form No. I to License Form No. XVI, appended to these rules, as applicable for the category of the license.

Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in these rules or any other rules for the time being in force, the Licenses already granted in any other Forms shall remain valid till 31.03.2009 and at the time of grant of License for the next period of settlement for the year 2009-10 onwards, license shall be granted in the specified License Form as applicable for the category of License

8. After sub-rule 2 of rule 8 insert the following sub-rule

“3. No License for retail sale of liquor or any other intoxicants shall be granted at a new site if the new site is situated within 720 feet from the mid point of any National Highway/State highway.

Explanation - For the purpose of this rule such part of National Highway/State Highway which are situated within the limits of any Municipal Corporation, City or Town of Municipality, or such other authority having population of twenty thousands or more, shall not be treated as restriction.
