NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to sub-section (3) of section 85 and section 86, read with sections 30, 31, 36, 37 and 37A of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 (Ben. Act V of 1909), the Governor is pleased hereby to make, with immediate effect, the following amendment in the West Bengal Excise (Selection of New Sites and Grant of license for Retail Sale of Liquor and Certain Other Intoxicants) Rules, 2003, published with this Department Notification No. 800-Ex dated the 19th July, 2003, as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the said rules):—

Amendment

In the said rules, add the proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 8 —

“Provided that if a road has to be crossed along the path which an ordinary prudent person normally takes to reach such new site and of the said road is marked by a ‘Zebra Crossing’ for pedestrians to cross, the said distance shall be measured taking into account the act that an ordinary prudent person, while walking, would have crossed the said road at the point marked by the ‘Zebra Crossing’ for pedestrians to cross”.
