4(o) - 25° UP Rum for consumption 'off' the site of existing country spirit and coloured and/or flavoured spirit shop or 25° UP Rum for consumption 'off' the site of existing <i>Bhang</i> shop or 25° UP Rum for consumption 'off' and/or 'on' the site of existing pachwai shop."	N
