NOTIFICATION

AND WHEREAS the Governor on being satisfied so to do, is pleased to discontinue the system of supply of 80 degree U.P. country spirit in bulk to enable such supply to be made in bottled form with declared MRP on the label affixed to such bottles in order to improve quality and to safeguard the health of consumers;

AND WHEREAS the licensees of the existing country spirit warehouses currently supplying 80 degree U.P. country spirit in bulk will have to set up country spirit bottling plants expeditiously to manufacture and supply 80 degree U.P. country spirit in bottled form;

AND WHEREAS the Governor is satisfied that under the circumstances certain requirements of the West Bengal Excise (Country Spirit) Rules, 2010, published by notification no.1320-Ex dated 12.11.2010 are required to be waived to enable the concerned licensees to set up bottling plants expeditiously;

AND WHEREAS it is observed that M/S Luksan Warehouse of Luksan, Jalpaiguri, produce only 80 degree U.P. bulk country spirit and do not have any bottling line;

Now, therefore, in order to enable them to produce bottled country spirit, the Governor is hereby pleased to waive the requirements of rules 4 to 7(5) of the West Bengal Excise (Country Spirit) Rules, 2010 in exercise of the powers conferred by rule 38 of the said rules. The Excise Commissioner is authorised to approve the required country spirit bottling plant license in favour of M/S Luksan Warehouse, Luksan, Jalpaiguri and direct the Collector of Excise to grant the license in their favour upon their application for the same and subsequent approval of the blue print plans by the Excise Commissioner, West Bengal.
