**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 27,38,85 and section 86 of the Bengal Excise act, 1909 (Ben Act V of 1909), the Government is pleased hereby to make the following amendment with effect from 10th February, 2011 in the West Bengal Excise (country spirit) Rules,2010 published under Excise Department Notification No. 1320 EX dated 12th November, 2010 :—

*Amendment*

In the said rule —

1. Insert the following words after first para in rule 21—

“The manufacturer shall manufacture, store and supply bottled country spirit of sizes and strengths as specified in these rules to the satisfaction of the Excise Commissioner”.

2. Insert “not” before the words ordinarily in rule in rule 27(2).

3. Substitute “West Bengal Excise Form no 5” in sub-rule 2 of rule 33 in place of “West Bengal Excise Form No. 6”

4. Insert new sub-rule (4) after sub-rule (3) in rule 33 —

“(4) The retail vendors shall return the empty bottles to the wholesale vendors and after receiving the said bottles in good condition the wholesale vendors shall refund the price of empty bottles as inscribed on the labels of the bottles to the retail vendors”

5. Insert clause (i) in rule 35(1) after clause (h) —

“(i) A sum of Rs. .... as the price of empty glass bottle shall be refundable when returned in good condition / ভালো অবস্থায় ফেরতযোগ্য বোতলের দাম।”

6. Insert after proviso of clause (f) of rule 35(6) the following words—

“provided further that the labels, which are already printed, and allowed to be pasted on the bottles of country spirit offered for sale without the inscription as mentioned in rule 35 (1) (i) shall be allowed to be used after inscription of the words noted in rule 35(1)(i), using a rubber stamp. No fresh registration fee shall be levied for such change.”
