NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 9 and the proviso to the sub-section (3) of section 85 of the Bengal Excise act, 1909 (Ben Act V of 1909), the Governor is pleased hereby to make, with immediate effect, the following amendments in the West Bengal Excise Foreign Liquor Form No: 5 as mentioned in West Bengal Excise (Foreign Liquor) Rules, 1998 as amended (Hereinafter referred to as the said Form):

*Amendments*

1. In the said Form substitute para A.6 by --

"A.6. The permit-cum-pass shall remain current for \*..... days from the date of issue of export pass or \*\*..... days from the date of issue of the Import Permit cum Pass, whichever is earlier

\* The number of days not exceeding seven or nine days as the case may be, will be fixed by the Excise Commissioner, West Bengal. (Seven days in case of Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab and Haryana, Jharkhand, Bihar and Orissa and nine days in case of Maharastra, Karnataka, Goa and other distantly located States.)

\*\* The number of days not exceeding thirty days will be fixed by the Excise Commissioner. "
