NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 9 and the proviso to the sub-section (3) of section 85 of the Bengal Excise act, 1909 (Ben Act V of 1909), the Governor is pleased hereby to make, with immediate effect, the following amendments in the West Bengal Excise Form No 70 DD (West Bengal Form No 056E) (Hereinafter referred to as the said Form)

Amendments

1. In the said Form in column under the heading "Particulars" in third row against the "Validity of Pass" under the heading "Item Description", for the words "export order", substitute the word "export pass";
2. In the said Form in column under the heading "Particulars" in third row against the "Validity of Pass" under the heading "Item Description", repeal the following clause-

"OR

*..... days from the date of receipt of this Import Permit cum pass or..... days from the date of issue of this Import Permit cum Pass, whichever is earlier"

3. In the said Form substitute clause beginning with "*" by -

"* The number of days not exceeding seven or nine days as the case may be, will be fixed by the Excise Commissioner, West Bengal. (Seven days in case of Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab and Haryana, Jharkhand, Bihar and Orissa and nine days in case of Maharastra, Karnataka, Goa and other distantly located States.)"
